Our Pediatric Primary Care Provider will be an integral part of our care team providing care for our patients and families. We use a non-RVU based salary structure and provide in-person Spanish language interpreters.

The successful candidate will:

- Examine children from infancy through adolescence to order, perform, and interpret diagnostic tests to obtain information on medical conditions and determine diagnosis.
- Examine children from infancy through adolescence regularly to assess their growth and development.
- Prescribe or administer treatment, therapy, medication, vaccination, and other specialized medical care to treat or prevent illness, disease, or injury for children from infancy through adolescence.
- Collect, record, and maintain patient information, such as medical history, reports, and examination results utilizing the clinic's EMR system. Charting must be completed within 48 hours of patient visit.
- Advise patients, parents or guardians, and community members concerning diet, activity, hygiene, and disease prevention.
- Treat children from infancy through adolescence who have minor illnesses, acute and chronic health problems, and growth and development concerns.
- Explain procedures and discuss test results or prescribed treatments with patients and parents or guardians.
- Monitor patients' conditions and progress and reevaluate treatments, as necessary.
- Plan and execute medical care programs to aid in the mental and physical growth and development of children from infancy through adolescence.
- Refer patients to appropriate medical specialists or other practitioners when necessary.
- Direct and coordinate activities of nurses, students, assistants, specialists, therapists, and other medical staff.
- Prepare reports for government or management of birth, death, and disease statistics, workforce evaluations, or medical status of individuals.

Minimum Qualifications Include:

- Experience: 2-5 years of pediatric experience
- Licenses/Certifications: Must hold current, non-restricted MD/DO/NP/PA license in the State of Oregon and hold DEA Certification.
- BLS/PALS Certification
- Ability to collaborate with an interdisciplinary care team and patients & families through effective written and verbal professional communication skills.
- Ability to multitask and be flexible in dealing with interruptions, a busy schedule, and a fast-paced work environment.
- Proficiency with utilizing electronic medical records including ability to document services in a clear, concise, and timely manner within 24-48 hours of each visit (concurrent documentation preferred)
- Ability to pass a multi-level background check.
- Up to date on all vaccinations including but not limited to, an initial series of COVID-19 vaccines.
- Spanish language speakers are preferred, but not required.
